REDUCING HOONING WITH THE BEACON COVE NEIGHBOURHOOD GROUP (BCNG)

Members of your committee have met with BCNG office bearers, to understand, and then offer our support, to this group's efforts of removing hoons from the area (noisy motorcycles etc). BCNG have been successful in having a mobile camera available through the summer months, to provide police with photos of offending vehicles. BCNG has worked with council, the local police commander and his predecessor, to successfully progress this issue.

WSKRA joined with the Port Philip Council to refurbish the toilets on Cummins Reserve at the beach end of Cowderoy Street. We hope you have found the refurbished and painted facilities useful.
